MONSIGNOR TOMÁŠ HALÍK is a celebrated author, academic and winner of the 2014 *Templeton Prize*, which recognises those who have made exceptional contributions to affirming life's spiritual dimension, through insight, discovery, or practical works. Ordained a priest in 1978, he worked in the "underground Church" and as a psychotherapist helping drug addicts. After the fall of Communism, he served as General Secretary to the Czech Conference of Bishops. In 1992, Pope John Paul II appointed him advisor to the Pontifical Council for Dialogue with Non-Believers and in 2009, Pope Benedict XVI granted him the title of Monsignor. Halik now teaches sociology at Charles University (Prague) and is pastor of the Academic Parish.
