Keynote Presentation: Fr Christian Fini OMI

“Creating a culture of leadership: inspiring, challenging and developing leaders.”

The culture of your youth group can affect your ability to run a fun and sustainable group. How do you build leadership and encourage your youth? Fr Fini will explore ways to inspire, challenge and develop your leadership team.

WORKSHOPS FOR ENTRY LEVEL YOUTH MINISTERS

1. Watch out!!! Burnout is on the horizon: The importance of Self Care in youth ministry (Dr Marcel Koper)

Youth ministry can be a tough field of work and many youth ministers burn out quickly. This workshop will look at strategies and techniques to encourage good self-care practices for youth ministers which will allow them to stay healthy and ministering to young people for longer.

2. “You’re not friends till you’re Facebook friends”: Helping young people safely navigate social media (Rhyannon Elliot)

We know that youth are frequently engaged with digital media, however are we aware of the impact that this can have on their perspective of the world and how they build relationships? This session explores methods the media uses to manipulate thinking and encourages youth ministers to recognise its impact on their young people.

3. Project and event planning for Youth Ministry (Jess Mills)

Whilst Youth Ministry is primarily focused on supporting young people, youth ministers inevitably will be required to become experts at managing and planning events as well! Learn some basic tools to accomplish projects from the early planning stages through to completion.

4. Understanding current Child Safety standards in a youth ministry context (Katherine Levi)

Feeling overwhelmed with current Child Safety laws and policies? In today’s world understanding the best ways to protect children is essential for youth ministry leaders. This workshop will break down the current policies into understandable and manageable requirements, through an interactive scenario based workshop.

5. How to use “Alpha” and other youth ministry programs in your youth ministry (Jacqui Guillianio)

Have you heard of the Alpha Course? Do you want to take your ministry in a new direction? Explore what Alpha has to offer and get insights into effective ways of incorporating other set programs into your youth ministry.

6. Structures of Sustainability: Creating a framework for eternal youth ministry (Fr Christian Fini, OMI)

This workshop will build on the keynote presentations, looking at some practical examples of structures and systems that can be put in place to create a more sustainable and enticing youth ministry.
