Session:

Explain the "the Spirit comes", the third in a series of Glorious Mystery paintings. The dreaming is the creator's dreaming. Our spirit is the dreaming. As aboriginal Christians we continually seek this power of the spirit, for our journey to help our people rise again.

About the artist: Lorraine Nelson, is a Victorian Koori, one of the stolen generation children. Lorraine is an extraordinarily gutsy woman who is very determined to paint. Lorraine's paintings represent the resurrection and the coming of the Spirit.

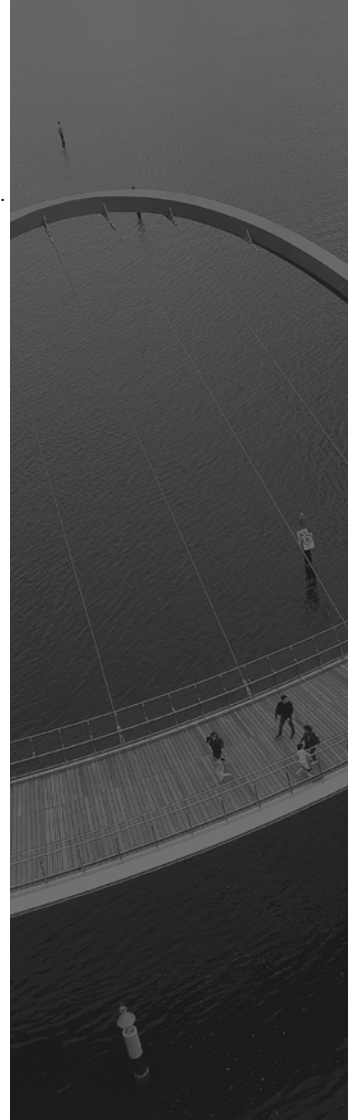
Distribute the reflection resource to pilgrims (available from cam.org.au/acyf19)

Play video 1, then have two minutes of silence before asking pilgrims to discuss the questions from handout (10mins):

Share some of the important voices/forces in your life.

What prejudices / preconceived ideas about yourself or others might you have to drop?

Is God an important voice? Why / why not?



Play video 2 plus discussion from handout (10mins):

Opening up to anyone is a choice and makes us vulnerable. Who do you trust to know you?

Have you ever opened up to God?

If yes, what has helped you do that?

If no, what's holding you back?

Play video 3 plus discussion from handout (10 mins):

The Spirit of God speaks into our life. Where do you recognise God / the Spirit's presence in your life?

Did one of the speakers sharing about where they find/hear/feel God resonate/challenge you?

Are you ready to open your ears/mind/heart to God, to 'let go', to say 'yes' on your personal journey?
